## **Benefits**

- Reciprocals with many other golf Clubs
- Personalized attention from the professional staff in all areas of the Clubhouse and Golf Shop
- Full driving range facilities and club storage service

In addition, because the Castlegar Golf Club is owned by the Members, the Members control Management direction and Club policy. This is achieved through an elected Board of Directors that ensures the best interests of the Members are first and foremost in determining direction and decision-making.

## **Tee Times**

Tee times can be booked 8 days prior or less in advance by calling the Golf Shop at 250.365.5006. Online booking is also available. Please remember to call us if you cannot make your tee time or if you expect more/less players in your group.

## **Dress Code**

All golfers are expected to dress in proper golfing attire; we require that the golfer's clothing be neat and not offensive to others. Golf clothing of the type displayed in the Golf Shop is recommended. Bare feet and shoes with metal spikes are prohibited. Tank tops, spaghetti strap t-shirts, halter tops, muscle shirts, half shirts, spandex shorts, and cut-offs are also prohibited. Questions regarding the acceptability of any apparel can be discussed with the Golf Shop staff.

Certain rates and times available may vary and are at the discretion of each Reciprocal Club. Members will be required to present a valid Membership card at time of check in. These special Reciprocal Privileges are provided to each Member in good standing. Please book these reciprocals through our Golf Shop.

## Alcohol Policy

Under no circumstances may alcohol that is not purchased from The Nineteenth restaurant or one of our Beverage Carts be brought onto the golf course property at any time. It is a violation of the Castlegar Golf Club's liquor license and B.C. Liquor Laws, and violators will be asked to leave the golf course and are subject to discipline.

## Fundamental Rules of Etiquette

Some fundamental rules of golf etiquette to follow at any Club would include raking your sand trap after use, replacing your divots (ask for demonstration if not sure how), patching divots on tees with sand from the bucket provided, allowing the group ahead of you to clear out of range before hitting, keeping power carts and pull carts well away from the greens and tees by following the cart paths, using the proper dress code, keeping the pace of play and by following the Club rules as posted.

## Driving Range

The Driving Range is located next to #1 fairway. This range is one of the best facilities you will see anywhere and can improve your game dramatically if you use it periodically. There are a number of packages offered for hitting practice balls ranging from warm up buckets to large usage packages for the season, so see our staff in the Golf Shop for more information. Also, located adjacent to the parking lot is a chipping green and practice bunker. The putting green is located near the Clubhouse.

## Handicapping

Members will have access to the Golf Canada Handicap System Card and will be able to post scores using the handicapping computer downstairs at the clubhouse or online at [www.golfcanada.ca](http://www.golfcanada.ca). All Members will require a valid Golf Canada handicap in order to compete in Club events. If you are having difficulty entering your score please see the staff in the Golf Shop or Administration Office and they would be happy to help.

## Golf Shop

Our fully stocked Golf Shop offers a wide selection of the latest in Men's and Women's golf apparel, footwear, equipment and accessories. The Golf Shop can equip you with everything you need to hit the links. Lockers are available for use down stairs in the Men's Locker Room. Club cleaning and storage is also available. For these services there is a small charge and arrangements can be made with the staff in the Golf Shop.

The Golf Shop is under the direction of General Manager, Pat Biln. Pat and his staff are committed to serving your needs. If you need any help with your game including lessons or equipment do not hesitate to ask Pat for help. You will find a full range of products available from the Shop and if you need other service in this area, the staff are eager to serve you. Power carts, pull carts and range passes can be booked through the Golf Shop as well. Also, Pat is fully trained to offer club fitting to ensure you are using the proper equipment to play the game. The Golf Shop staff are committed to consistently delivering the highest quality Golf Shop services and will continue to match Golf Town pricing.

The Administration Office is open Monday to Friday from 8:00-4:00pm. We are very happy and willing to answer any questions you may have.

## Weekly Activities
